He started work in Central Africa, advising the local farmers on ways to improve their crop yields, then joined a USA seed company where he worked for the rest of his 30 plus years. His work covered all aspects of growing good healthy field and vegetable crops for seed production. While based in Michigan, then California, his work took him to a total of 26 countries where the various seed crops were being grown. Julian retired from seed production five years ago, and is an active volunteer in the Ventura Master Gardener program.
