















Low maintenance perennial producing long, leafy stems of brightly colored yellow, orange, peach, pink, red, or magenta flowers resembling small lilies.

Multiplies on tuberous underground roots as well as by seed; can become invasive.

<u>Deciduous</u> form produces leaves in winter replaced by flowers in late spring. No summer water.

<u>Evergreen</u> varieties form clumping mounds that bloom for long periods with some summer water.

Suggested varieties: Litgu and Dr. Salter's hybrids (deciduous); A. aurea hybrids (evergreen)

Other: Good drainage. Afternoon shade inland.
