


California Lilac

Ceanothus spp.



Mounding evergreen varying from groundcover to large shrub or tree producing profuse clusters of tiny blue flowers in mid-spring. Thrives on neglect. Afternoon shade inland.

Suggested varieties: C. griseus horizentalis (groundcover); 'Joyce Coulter' (low shrub); 'Julia Phelps' (medium to large shrub); 'Ray Hartman' (large shrub/small tree)

Other: Good drainage. Little to no summer water. Small-leafed varieties deer resistant. Attracts birds, butterflies, and hummingbirds
