- Energy






### <u>Planning</u>

### NRCS Competitive Programs

- Folks with an NRCS Approved Conservation Plan have a competitive advantage.
- Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP)
- A voluntary program designed to promote environmental quality.
  - Provides financial and technical assistance to eligible farmers and growers to address soil, water, air qualities, wildlife habitat, surface and ground water conservation, energy conservation, and related natural resource concerns.



# What things can I do under EQIP? Environmental Quality Incentive Program

 Improve Irrigation Efficiency—through improved irrigation systems or irrigation water management.

Improve Water Quality—Irrigation water

management, nutrient

and pest management.

Reduce Soil Erosion
