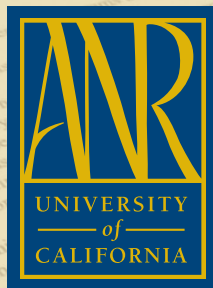

Office of Risk Services

Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) uses a broad definition of risk as any event or action that can hinder an organization's ability to reach its objectives. In this definition, we all practice risk management as we carry out our day-to-day activities. ERM can be applied to policies, practices, and institutional culture, enabling ANR leaders to understand, prioritize, and control risks that threaten the well being of ANR programs and services, its partners, the communities in which it operates, and society at large.

The Office of Risk Services uses ERM methods to develop programs that protect academics, staff, volunteers, and other stakeholders from unanticipated loss by:

- Providing systematic analysis to identify, prioritize and monitor risks
- Developing and implementing techniques to reduce potential exposures
- Administering University insurance programs
